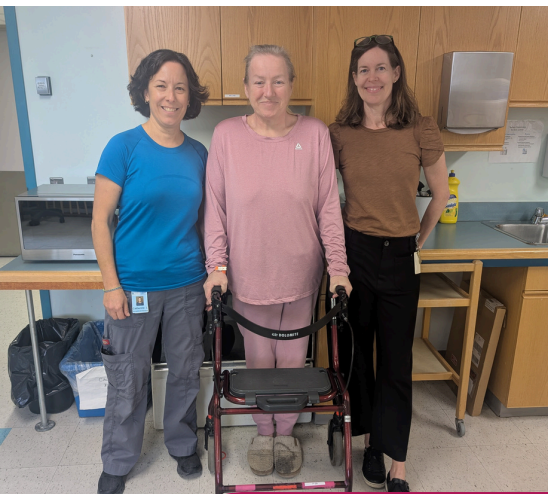

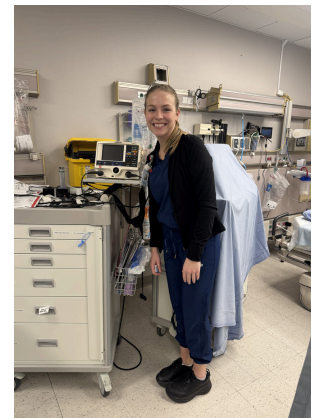

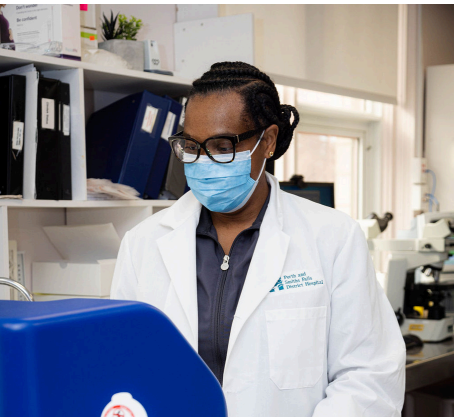

Your commitment is making a lasting difference throughout our region.



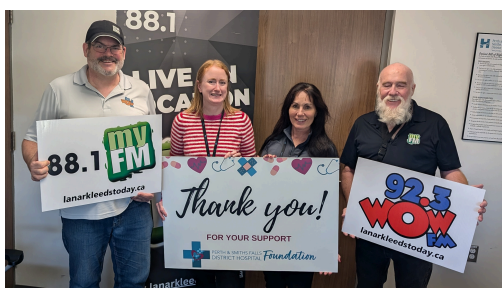

Thanks to the generosity of Janis, Shannon, volunteers, runners, walkers, donors, sponsors the event raised an incredible \$3,850!



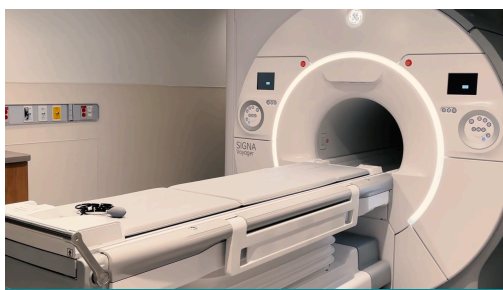

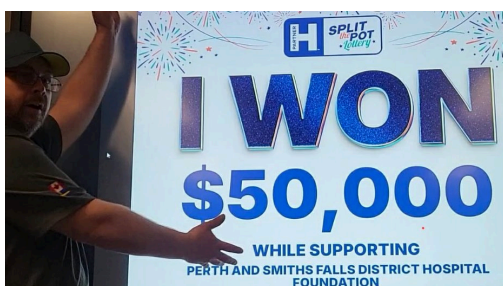
With a \$10,000 donation from the Kinsmen Club of Smiths Falls, the grand total soared to \$19,891!

Split the Pot Lottery

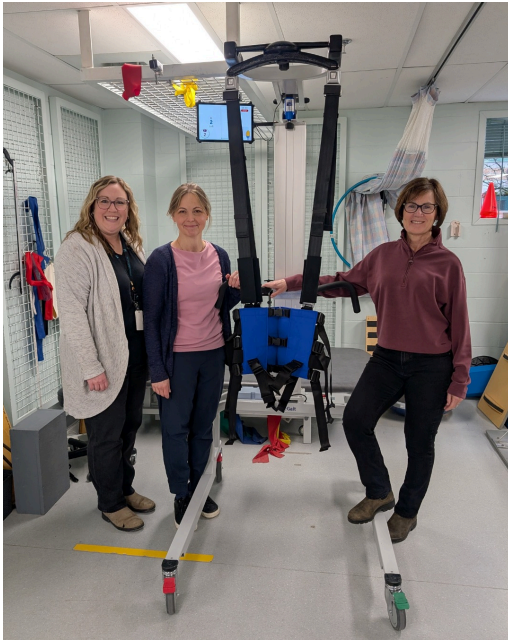
The Split the Pot Lottery has raised over \$40,000 for the MRI to date!

Powered by Generosity



Thanks to a generous donation from Dr. Kate Stolee and Jim Noble, the Perth and Smiths Falls District Hospital has recently introduced the LiteGait® body weight support system, a specialized rehabilitation device designed to assist patients in safely relearning walking and postural control.

The system employs an overhead frame and harness to partially support a patient's weight while permitting natural movement on a treadmill or over ground. By reducing the risk of falls and reducing the physical demands of the task, it enables patients to initiate walking practice earlier and with greater confidence under the close supervision of a therapist.

This body weight support system is particularly beneficial for individuals recovering from neurological injuries, such as stroke, or for those with limb loss learning to walk with a prosthesis.

Because of this generosity, patients at our hospital are able to take meaningful steps forward in their recovery with greater confidence, dignity, and independence.

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, new Coagulation Analyzers have recently been installed at both hospital sites. These vital laboratory instruments help healthcare teams diagnose bleeding and clotting disorders, monitor life-saving medications, and make informed decisions before surgery and during treatment.

Behind every test is a person waiting for answers, a family seeking reassurance, or a healthcare professional making critical decisions. In the last year alone, 249,922 laboratory tests were performed at PSFDH.

Reliable, up-to-date equipment helps ensure those results are available quickly and accurately when they matter most.

At approximately \$45,000 each, these analyzers are an important investment in patient care one that was made possible through donor support.

Powered by Generosity



We are so excited and deeply grateful to share that our hospital has a brand-new Babyroo® TN300 as well as a Bililux phototherapy unit made possible because of the generous donations from our community.

These important pieces of equipment are valued at approximately \$66,000.

The Babyroo® TN300 is an advanced open-care radiant warmer designed to help newborns and infants maintain a safe, stable body temperature immediately after birth. It also includes emergency respiratory support and suction capabilities, allowing our care teams to respond quickly when every second matters.

The phototherapy lights are used to treat neonatal jaundice (hyperbilirubinemia), one of the most common conditions affecting newborns.

Jaundice occurs in approximately 60% of healthy newborns and nearly all preterm infants. Left untreated, severe jaundice can lead to serious complications, making timely treatment incredibly important.

Phototherapy provides a gentle, non-invasive treatment using specialized blue-green light to safely lower bilirubin levels, helping babies recover while remaining close to their care team and family.

For families welcoming a new baby this equipment means comfort, safety, and peace of mind when it matters most.
